Next year, we will continue to bank on teamwork, appreciation, and mutual acceptance in order to shape our cooperation in the best possible way.


In this spirit, we wish you and your families all the best and a merry and blessed Christmas.






#### NAME CHANGE IN THE H&G GROUP



In recent years, important restructuring has taken place within the H&G Group. For example, Stahlbehälterbau Greis GmbH was renamed H&G Produktion und Service GmbH in 2020 so that the field of "after sales", such as maintenance, repair and spare parts delivery is processed and handled by company. Now, we are going one step further and are handling the complete field of disposal technology (screw compactors, underground and container systems) via H&G Produktion und Service GmbH. This also includes the new machine business. We have already implemented this change in our ERP system as of August 01, 2022. Since the name H&G Entsorgungssysteme GmbH is already established as a strong partner in the market, and due to the fact it reflects our core competence and company purpose perfectly, we will transfer the name to H&G Produktion und Service GmbH on January 01, 2023, which will - from this date - operate name H&G Entsorgungssysteme GmbH. The original H&G Entsorgungssysteme GmbH was renamed H&G Management GmbH on November 21, 2022. This company will exclusively handle the rental of machines and containers from now on.

With this restructuring, we have already achieved a great simplification of the processes within the company and are convinced that we will continue to be successful as a competent partner on the market of disposal technology in the future.

### **NEW COATING LINE**

#### Completion of the first of two new coating lines

With the start-up of the first of two new coating lines, we can significantly increase the surface quality and cycle time of our products and meet the sophisticated requirements of our customers even better. The heart of our new line is the paint mixing room. The separated multi-component line is controlled entirely electronically. The installed piston pumps from the manufacturer Wagner (IceBreaker) are, due to their high performance and efficiency, among the market leaders in the field of 2-K coating systems. The coating and evaporation systems, each with a size of approx. 10 m x 16 m, were developed and installed together with the manufacturer "Durst".

**Environmental protection and economy:** The paint shops are each equipped with two recirculation towers, which ensure that a high proportion of the filtered exhaust air can be returned to the painting area.

Better capacity utilization, less stress: With the new line, we can control the production processes much better than before. We have shorter throughput times and, thanks to the new multi-component system, significantly lower paint consumption with improved surface quality. This is already reducing the bottleneck in the paint shop and therefore also means less stress for our employees. The new coating lines have made the jobs in the company more attractive and have created a positive atmosphere among the workforce.

#### **H&G** goes Asia

Pilot project with new partner in Singapore

At the end of December, H&G will deliver three 15 kW screw compactors with cardboard pre-crushers to Singapore. These machines are destined for a customer from the furnishing industry, but sales and installation will be handled by H&G's new sales partner, INVENT Engineering (www.inventgroup.sg).

INVENT is the leading provider of engineering solutions in the waste management industry in Singapore and specializes in the distribution and repair of equipment and vehicles as well as the fabrication of steel structures in the waste management, construction and marine industries.

In September, a first cooperation agreement was signed between H&G and INVENT and the first three machines for the pilot project were ordered by INVENT. With INVENT as our local partner, H&G will take the first steps in the Asian market and hopefully place more machines there soon. In this endeavor, INVENT will support us as a competent partner with decades of experience. We are looking forward to a successful cooperation.







#### Sales and marketing training for our French partner "SOLEN"

Presentations from our sales and technical colleagues, live demonstrations of our screw compactors in the test center, as well as relaxed moments full of fun, laughter and constructive discussions were on the agenda of the sales and marketing training.













We are pleased to celebrate 17 years of partnership with Europress. Our cooperation started in 2005 and since then, Europress has been distributing our screw compactors via their subsidiaries in Finland, Sweden, Denmark, Norway and Poland.

Due to the high requirements of their customers in the industrial and waste disposal sectors, a continuous technical development of the system technology is vital. #### **NERTHERLANDS**

In the course of the production expansion of a fast-growing company based in the Netherlands (importer of vegetables and exotic fruits from all over the world), a total of four screw compactors for the fractions plastic and cardboard were installed in July 2022.

The design, as well as the planning of the installation process, were vital because of the high filling chutes and additional installations inside the building (conveyor belts / filling chutes).

The customer now has the option to feed the recyclables to our screw compactors via various feeding options (manual / automatic / by lift-and-tilt unit), as well as from several floor levels of the building. Our machines compact the material in the usual manner, powerfully, reliably and with high efficiency. Increased filling weights are guaranteed.

We are very proud of the outstanding and top-quality performance of our team.

#### **Screw compactor TO GO**

Late this summer, H&G delivered two mobile screw compactors with integrated weighing unit and access control to one of our customers in Switzerland. This system is unique. The special challenge was to design the electrical control of the machine in such a way that it could be plugged into conventional CEE sockets and still compact the waste as efficiently as usual. For this purpose, a frequency controlled main drive motor was used.

The automatic weighing data recording in connection with the access control also allows for a simple user-based billing.





### **ITALIEN**

This year, we have also realized interesting projects for our customers in Italy. In October of 2022, two H&G screw compactors equipped with cardboard precrushers were designed and delivered for the warehouse of a large e-commerce company in Vercelli.

Huge thanks to all colleagues involved who made this installation a great success.







#### **HAMM**

#### Fourth large project for a logistics service provider


This client is a global logistics services company that develops and implements innovative solutions for business customers in the sectors of fashion, cosmetics, telecommunications, etc. - such as service centers and IT systems, or logistics and financial services.

At the Hamm site, a screw compactor system with cardboard pre-crusher and Y-shaped filling chute was installed for a large international company operating in the "perfumery" sector. In addition to this, the system was equipped with 3 lift-and-tilt units. The screw compactor is primarily fed by on-site intralogistics or conveyor belt system. The feeding of cardboard boxes with an edge length of up to 600 mm runs fully automatically and is controlled and monitored in a process-stable manner via a complex signal transmission system.

This is already the fourth joint project on this scale.

## **WÜRZBURG**

#### New customer, new challenge

The IFAT trade fair, which took place in Munich in May of this year, was the first step towards a new customer. We succeeded in generating a great project in the field of underground systems. From May to September of this year, the first three underground systems "Europa Plus" were installed in Würzburg.

We delivered another three systems of the same design in November.

The modern design of the system, as well as the 100% liquid-tight containers, contribute significantly to the beautification of the living environment and make disposal more efficient and at the same time sustainable. This was the deciding factor for the customer who is more than satisfied with the new system.











For the "light packaging" fraction, we used our standard system.

With a capacity of 3 m³ for organic waste disposal and 5 m³ for residual waste, the H&G underground systems are the ideal solution for this part of Würzburg. We are very pleased about the positive feedback of "Stadtreiniger Würzburg", the company responsible for the disposal.

#### **KARLSRUHE**

After months of hard work we delivered 38 roll-on/off containers to our customer in Karlsruhe.

This waste disposal project comprised planning, designing and manufacturing of a total of 38 containers. Each phase of the project was handled individually in order to meet the requirements of the customer.

And this is exactly what keeps us dynamic as a team.

In-house expertise – beyond departmental boundaries – in design and development.

The roll-on/off containers are designed to be multifunctional. This way, they can be transported by means of either truck or train, but also by means of a gantry crane.











### RHEIN-HUNSRÜCK-KREIS

It is always great to be able to realize a project for the fire department, helping them to make their important work more efficient and safer. This year, our team worked very hard on the concept, design and completion of a fire water tank for the fire department of the Rhein-Hunsrück district.

With a capacity of 10,000 liters, two manholes and an equipment room, this mobile fire water tank is a functional as well as safe solution for our customer.

Alexandra Henrich, who has been passionately working in the export sector for more than 20 years, is the responsible manager.


All of us represent concentrated female power.

#### INTERNAL TRAINING OF OUR TEAM


At regular intervals, our colleagues from project management, work preparation, as well as mechanical and control engineering conduct internal product training events for the sales team.
